What do you know about Monroeville's new public water source? Join us as Matthew T. Junker, Public Relations Specialist for Municipal Authority of Westmoreland County (MAWC), demonstrates how Monroeville's water, now sourced from Beaver Run Reservoir, is professionally treated before it reaches our homes. He will focus on various water treatments (e.g., chlorine and ammonia, anti-corrosion additives), the research on each and the rationale for their use. He will also discuss water analysis and metal contaminants such as lead that affect water quality.

Matthew Junker graduated from Penn State University with a BA in Journalism. He worked as a reporter for Trib Total Media for ten years and in government for ten years as a special projects director for the Pennsylvania Senate and as chief of staff for a Westmoreland County Commissioner. He recently joined MAWC and serves on the PMAA (Pennsylvania Municipal Authorities Association) Legislative Water Subcommittee, which reviews and proposes legislation and regulations, assists in defining and pursuing PMAA legislative priorities, and recommends policy positions to the PMAA Board of Directors.
